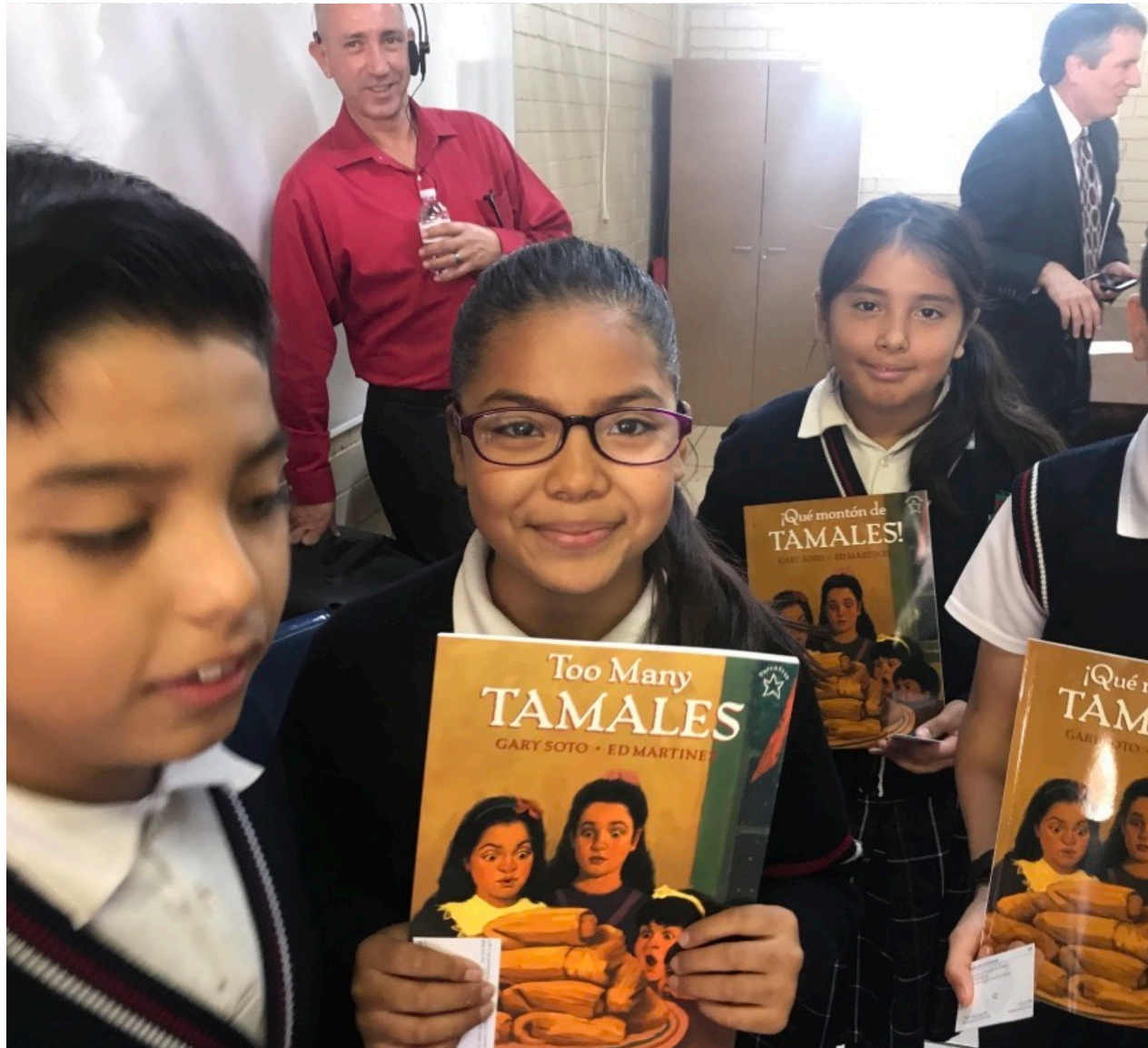

TRANSBORDER STUDENT

- “I was born in Los Angeles, CA but last year my mother was deported so now we are here in Tijuana, Mexico. I am very sad because my dad is still in LA working and I miss him and all of my friends. Here I feel lost because my teacher can’t understand that I don’t speak Spanish even though I am Mexican. Here I feel really sad because I don’t understand most of what is being taught and there is no one to help me. *Es que yo no sé hablar español muy bien.* My mom should have her immigration papers in two more years and then we can all return to LA and live a normal life. *Es que ahorita no soy ni de aquí ni de allá* [right now I am not from here (Mexico) or from there (California)].”

- CAFE works closely with Mexico and its consular network in California to promote access to information and services, and participation during our annual and regional conferences

- First Cohort - July 2016
 - 13 CA Spanish DLI teachers + 20 Baja teachers
- Support and Follow up - 2016 and 2017
- Second Cohort - July 2018
 - 20 CA Spanish DLI teachers + Baja teachers
 - 8 SEI teachers+ Baja teachers
 - Can take up to 30 each from CA and from Baja California

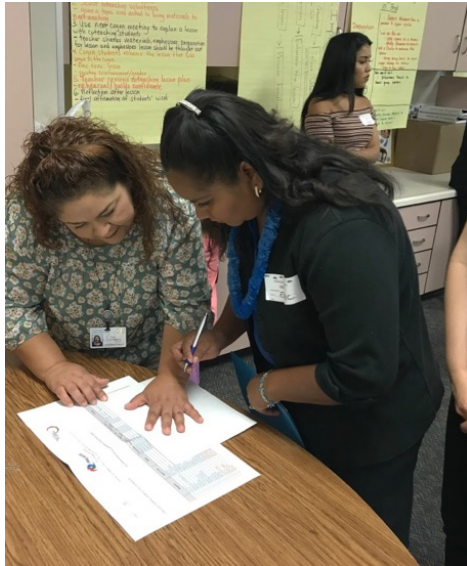
