6.4 California Aspiring Bilingual Author Award

A proposal from Velazquez Press and DualLanguageSchools.org

Goals:

- Inspire more California bilingual writers to share their California stories
- Develop quality bilingual materials for bilingual programs or dual language schools
- Support the development of aspiring bilingual authors
- Establish the CABE award as a highly sought after bilingual author award

Proposed Steps:

- 1. CABE and DualLanguagesSchoools.org will decide the award categories, criteria and assemble the panel of judges
- 2. The award winners will be guaranteed a publishing contract by Velazquez Press with a guaranteed royalties advance.
- 3. DualLanguageSchools.org will take care of the book submission mechanism and charge a nominal fee for the book submission to each author. The fees will cover the cost of the judge and other logistic cost.
- 4. CABE will hold professional workshops to guide teachers who are interested in bilingual education writing—still in the development process. Workshop attendees will received a significant discount for the book submission.
- 5. An event would be held at CABE's annual conference to give out award(s) to new California aspiring bilingual writer(s).
- 6. Velazquez Press will pay \$5,000 to CABE in 2017 to sponsor the event ceremony (above and beyond their other sponsorship)
- 7. The award will be announced at 2016 CABE San Francisco and the first event will be held at 2017 CABE Anaheim.

NOTE: CABE PDS is considering offering a bilingual book writing and illustration seminar in the summer of 2016 or 2017.
