

Item 4.3. CABE 2022 BOARD AWARD PROCESS

As approved by the Board in September 21, 2019, an online nomination and selection process for CABE Annual Board awards was developed for Board members to nominate awardee candidates.

The CABE Board Awards are provided during the annual conference to honor individuals or organizations for their outstanding work and impact in the area of biliteracy and multilingualism that exemplified our CABE Vision and Mission. The award categories are:

- Courage to Act/Social Justice
- Legacy
- Legislation & Policy
- Media
- Visual & Performing Arts
- Visionary
- Other

Due to the conference schedule, CABE historically has honored 3-4 awardees at the annual conference, however there is not a definite number of board awardees that are required to be selected.

The online nomination process includes board members providing the following via an online form by the determined deadline :

- Name of Nominator
- Name of Nominee and contact information
- Qualifications/Description of why the nominee is deserving of the CABE Board Award
- Suggested category for the award

After the deadline, the CABE Team will send the board a summary of the candidates and an online form to vote on the candidates of their choice with a determined deadline by which to respond.

After the results are received, it will be determined which candidates have received a majority vote. They will be notified by the CEO and the CABE Team and invited to accept the award at the annual conference. If they accept, arrangements for their being present at the conference will be made, and they will be asked to provide a preferred photo and bio.
