EDUC 698 Requirements

For each module, the required assignment involves a three-part written reflection on the module prompt. All three parts must be clearly identified in the paper to receive full credit. Please refer to the assignment rubric.

- What was learned about the module's prompt and how it builds upon their prior knowledge/pedagogical practice;
- 2. What was read about the prompt (1-2 additional references/sources); and
- What was applied from what they learned (from module attendance and reading) to a classroom setting.

Additional requirements

- Three (3) pages typed, double-spaced
- At least 1-2 references cited related to assignment and module content
- Should equal at least 6 hours independent work (beyond module on-site attendance)

In order to earn graduate units, educators attend a CABE-sponsored 6-hour professional development session then complete the following steps.

- Identify and read the necessary articles or chapters from a book that deepens and/or extends your professional development learning. The articles or book should connect to the professional development topic you attended.
- Submit a summary paper that synthesizes the additional readings, synthesizes what you've learned, and identifies implications for practice in your own classroom or context
- 3. Include a complete reference list to cite documents additional readings
- 4. All assignments are due one month from professional development session
