Jaime Carias, MPP, is a nationally recognized educator, bilingual author, and keynote speaker celebrated for his disruptive approach to learning and leadership. A thought leader in working with Generations Z, Alpha, and Beta, he guides families and educators in understanding these emerging cohorts—equipping them with the insights and strategies needed to succeed in K-12 education. Over his 20-year career, Jaime has collaborated with the California Department of Education (CDE), the California Association of Latino Superintendents & Administrators (CALSA), the California Association for Bilingual Education (CABE), the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD), the Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE), the United States Hispanic Leadership Institute (USHLI), the Illinois Legislative Latino Caucus Foundation (ILLCF) and many more in over 35 states across the country. Drawing on his upbringing in South Central Los Angeles and his triumph over a stuttering disability, he inspires communities nationwide with his motto, “Give yourself a chance.” The proud son of Guatemalan immigrants, Jaime earned degrees from UC Santa Barbara and the USC Sol Price School of Public Policy. Today, he continues to equip educators, parents, and students with the mindsets and skillsets needed to thrive in post-COVID education and is currently writing a memoir chronicling his ongoing stuttering problem and lifelong commitment to educational innovation.
