This month, we are proud to spotlight Rubí Flores, CABE's Director of Professional Learning Services (PLS). Born in San Luis Potosí in Central Mexico, Rubí immigrated to San Antonio, Texas with her family when she was twelve years old. As a newcomer 7th grader in middle school, she struggled to learn a new language and culture as an English learner in a school with no bilingual program.

To no one's surprise, she was ultimately successful and became the first person from both sides of her family to go to college. When she learned as a first-generation college freshman at Texas State University in San Marcos that it was possible to earn a degree in bilingual education, she was determined to become a bilingual teacher so that she could help other English learner students like herself. She married her bilingual husband, Abe, and had their first child while finishing her B.A. in Interdisciplinary Studies (bilingual education). She went on to earn an M.A. in Bilingual/Bicultural Curriculum and Instruction at the University of Texas, Austin.

Rubí started her career as a bilingual firstgrade teacher in Texas and later taught English and a variety of subjects and grades at a bilingual school in El Salvador where her husband was transferred. Later they moved to Oklahoma City where she taught ESL before returning to Round Rock, Texas as a dual language teacher and instructional coach for nine years. In 2017, her family moved to California where she served as a TOSA at the Norton Space Academy charter school, before joining CABE six months later as a Professional Learning Specialist. Less than two years later, she was promoted to her current director position at CABE.





As a passionate believer in CABE's vision and mission, Rubí explains why she joined Team CABE, "As an English learner myself and the parent of two dual language program students, I saw the potential to support our community of English learners across California by providing teachers with high-quality professional learning experiences." Rubí is very proud of her parents for their courage to immigrate to the US and create a better life for their children. Because of them, she has had many opportunities and, in turn, has been able to create opportunities for other students and educators, as well.

Rubí lives with her husband Abraham, her daughter Aly (18), a Seal of Biliteracy graduate starting at CSU San Marcos this fall, and her youngest daughter Abigail (14), a Pathways Towards Biliteracy Award recipient who will be a freshman in the Corona-Norco USD. In their free time, Rubí and her family enjoy traveling and exploring locally and out of state. They love to visit beaches and check out new restaurants with Dad, a self-professed BBQ connoisseur. When not developing powerful professional learning at CABE, Rubí also enjoys walking, listening to eclectic music, dancing, and snuggling with her toy poodle, Buddy.

An Update from CDE on the Biliteracy Pathway Recognition...

The 2021–22 school year was the first year that the Biliteracy Pathway Recognitions were available to preschool through grade 8 students on the path to developing literacy in two or more languages. The California Department of Education (CDE) Multilingual Support Division (MSD) is pleased to announce preliminary data highlights from the first year of implementation.

Preliminary data highlights:

- 58 districts and charter organizations in 16 counties participated
- Over 19,700 recognitions were awarded to students
- 80 percent of the students recognized were current or former English learners
- Over 2,800 students qualified for more than one recognition


The CDE MSD is thrilled to recognize the next generation of multiliterate Californians. This pool of students represents potential future State Seal of Biliteracy recipients who will help our state thrive in the global economy.


