It increases musical prowess, bilingualism, and retention in schools.

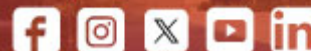

BE A PART OF EDUCATION EQUITY POLICY HISTORY

Many of you have helped us read and rate several LCAPs in relationship to how well districts address the needs of English Learners. Others have seen our reports and know the importance of keeping districts focused on improving programs and services for ELs. Your work helped us produce three important reports that impacted the design and content of the newest template that districts use to write a three-year LCAP.

We are going to read LCAPs again but with a different focus.

- 1 How did policy changes in the LCAP template result in greater evidence of equity for EL/MLs in districts with high numbers/percentages?
- 2 To what degree were the needs of the different EL profiles, including DLLs and LTELs, considered when identifying actions addressing language programs and professional development specific to these student subgroups?
- 3 For which indicators are ELs performing at the lowest performance level and how are the goals, actions and services targeted to address their needs?
- 4 Did the districts identify metrics to reduce the disparities in outcomes and opportunities between English learners and other student groups?
- 5 How were the educational partners engaged in development of a plan to address and reduce the disparities of opportunities and outcomes between ELs and other student groups?
