



These \$10,000 grants support schoolor program-wide initiatives that advance dual-language (Spanish-English) education for bilingual students.





# **Program Details:**

- Eligible schools must be a Title I public or charter elementary school serving bilingual students in one of the following locations:
  - California: Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, or Ventura counties
  - Florida: Broward or Miami-Dade counties
  - Texas: Dallas or Hidalgo counties
- Eligible schools must have an established dual-language (Spanish-English) program with at least one year of implementation.
- Grant applications must be submitted by the principal on behalf of their school by March 9, 2025 at 11:59 p.m. local time.
